


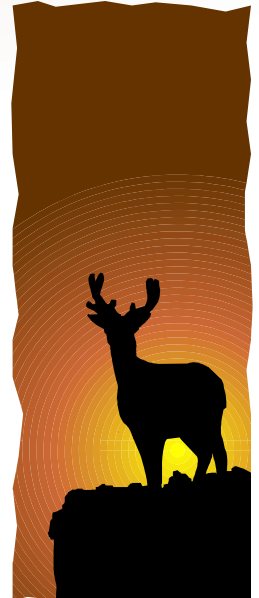
The Elks Would Like to TAN YOUR HIDE

The Veterans Leather Committee is collecting deer, elk and other animal hides which will be tanned and distributed for recreational and occupational therapy throughout the Veterans Administration health-care system. Tanned leather is also cut and sewn into specially designed fingerless gloves, which are furnished to Veterans confined to wheelchairs to protect their hands during movement.
